D-TEACH: DIGITAL TEACHING TOOLS

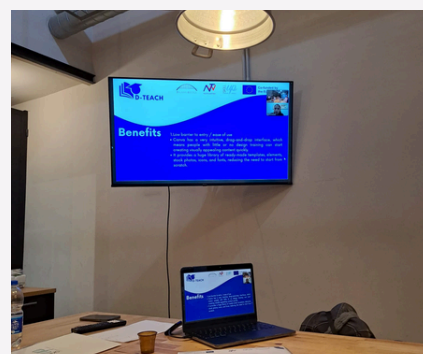
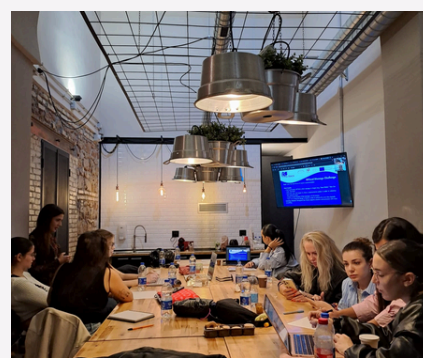
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The Final Step of Our Digital Journey

From **15 to 17 October 2025**, the partners of the **D-TEACH – Digital Teaching Tools** project gathered in **Rome** for the project's final **Learning, Teaching, and Training Activity (LTTA)**, hosted by **Skill Up (Italy)**.

Trainers from **Bulgaria, Spain, and Italy** came together to test the **Experiential Learning Guide** — the core result of the project — and to exchange experiences, ideas, and feedback on how digital tools can make teaching more interactive, creative, and engaging.



Exploring the Educational Applications

ACTIVITY 4

During the three-day training, participants worked hands-on with six selected educational apps:

- **Canva** and **Miro** (presented by Balkan Bridge)
- **CapCut** and **Genially** (presented by Neotalentway)
- **ChatGPT** and **Kahoot** (presented by Skill Up)

Each session included a presentation of the **Interactive Didactic Guide**, a **digital escape room challenge**, and an **evaluation** through QR codes. Trainers had the opportunity to experiment with the tools, reflect on their teaching potential, and share how they could be integrated into their daily work.

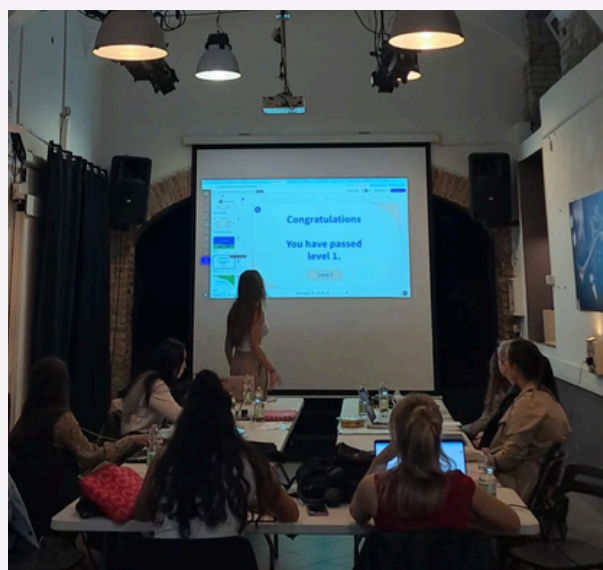

An Inspiring International Exchange

The LTTA brought together **12 participants** — trainers and staff from the three partner countries — in an atmosphere of collaboration and enthusiasm. The sessions encouraged peer learning, cross-cultural dialogue, and hands-on experimentation.

The results of the evaluations showed **high satisfaction levels**, confirming that the Experiential Learning Guide successfully enhances teachers' digital competence and creativity.



Final Steps and Looking Ahead

The project is now entering its final phase. Partners are preparing the final report and ensuring that all materials — including the guides, escape rooms, and videos — are available on the **project website** in **English, Bulgarian, Spanish, and Italian**.
